

- Emily Girimont and Misty Patel who will be assisting with greeting cards


Pen Pals



Person-Centered Trauma-Informed (PCTI) Care Training January 14, 2021 from 3 pm to 4pm

In partnership with Jewish Family Service through the generous support of the Jewish Federations of North America, CONTACT Cape-Atlantic is offering Person-Centered Trauma-Informed (PCTI) Care Trainings for our clients and volunteers.

PCTI Care focuses on the needs of individuals who have experienced trauma to create an environment that fosters collaboration and promotes a feeling of safety and security. The onset of Covid-19 has made this training especially important.

Individuals who participant in the training will have the opportunity to:

- Gain a clearer understanding of the nature of trauma
- Discover strategies to help Holocaust survivors cope with the impact of trauma in their everyday lives
- Explore the effect of "secondary trauma" passed down from generation to generation. The trainer is Sharon Simon, Supervisor of the Rothenberg Center for Family Life who is a second generation Holocaust survivor. During her 18 years at Jewish Family Service, she has facilitated both group and individual skill-based communication, trauma-informed, resiliency and general wellness trainings. She holds a Parent Educator Certificate from the Institute for Professional Education and Development which is part of the Lakeside Educational Network in Fort Washington, PA. Her training includes brain-based, trauma-informed, resiliency prac-
